Martha Graham on the Hidden Danger of Comparing Yourself to Others

Graham said, "There is a vitality, a life force, an energy, a quickening that is translated through you into action, and because there is only one of you in all of time, this expression is unique. And if you block it, it will never exist through any other medium and it will be lost. The world will not have it. It is not your business to determine how good it is nor how valuable nor how it (your work) compares with other expressions. It is your business to keep it yours clearly and directly, to keep the channel open."

1. The Uselessness of Judging Yourself

The key is to not let your self-judgment keep you from doing your thing. <u>Professionals produce</u>, even when it isn't easy. The ability to show up every day, stick to the schedule, and do the work — especially when you don't feel like it — is so valuable that it is literally all you need to become better 99% of the time.

2. Keep Your Eyes on Your Own Paper

When you have a blank canvas, your concern is to do the work, not to judge it. Your concern is to <u>fall in love</u> <u>with the process</u>, not to grade the outcome. Keep your eyes on your own paper.

Really successful people feel the same boredom and the same lack of motivation that everyone else feels. They don't have some magic pill that makes them feel ready and inspired every day. But the difference is that the people who stick with their goals don't let their emotions determine their actions. Top performers still find a way to show up, to work through the boredom, and to embrace the daily practice that is required to achieve their goals.

Submission Criteria

For more than 20 years, the Springfield Art Guild (SAG) has partnered with the Friends of Green Spring Gardens Park to create a juried public exhibition and sale of original artwork and photographs.

- Artwork must focus on flora, fauna, or local (DC, MD, VA) landscapes.
- Artwork must be for sale and if selected stay on exhibition from August 30 to October 24, 2016 in Green Spring Gardens Park
- SAG members may submit up to 3 pieces of artwork no larger than 40" x 40" (including frame)
- Only hand painted, hand drawn or other "original" 2-D art will be considered. Traditional photographs and digitally enhanced photographs are welcome. **Drafts, photocopies, offset prints, lithographs or copies of already published art will not be permitted.**
- All artwork must be for sale and suitable framed. Entries must be ready to hang with hooks and wire and be protected by glass or plexi-glass when necessary.
- Saw tooth hangers, clips, wet canvases, soiled or poorly matted works will not be accepted, nor will artwork previously shown at a SAG sponsored Green Spring Gardens show. Exposed nails must be covered by a backing and or tape.
- Artists making sales shall submit a 15% commission to Green Spring Gardens Park at the close of the show and are responsible for Virginia sales tax which Green Spring Gardens Park will collect. All sales will be made through Green Spring Gardens Park. Artists will be provided sales details when work is accepted for the show.



Don't worry if you have no idea what that color is. I'll teach you a few things about color and the beautiful and very useful color wheel. Although this is not a Color THEORY class, you will learn some anyway while making a harmonious painting! This time you will get to focus on the INTENSITY (brightness or dullness) of color as well as value (always)! I will have reference photos for inspiration but bring some of your own if you'd like. You will leave with a matted painting ready for a 8x10 frame.

Each class is 2.5 hours. All watercolor supplies are provided. Just bring a dish of something to share and a beverage of your choice. The fee is \$35 or if you bring a friend it is \$60 for both. 
