

Susan strives to create a balance between the uniqueness of her subject through both representational and abstract expressions. She finds tremendous inspiration in how these elements intertwine and influence the perception of art. Susan holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts from the University of Michigan and graduate studies with internationally recognized instructors at the University of Michigan, Rhode Island School of Design, Corcoran School of Art, Studio Incaminati in Philadelphia, and The Art League.



Susan's many years of diverse experience have honed her artist's eye and provided varied opportunities to exhibit her work and teach internationally.

An award-winning artist, Susan's enthusiastic, informative teaching style emphasizes the importance of a strong foundation and design principles in any medium to achieve fresh and unique works of art.

She is an energetic and engaging instructor, encouraging structure and expression of character in her figure drawing and watercolor courses. In support of the 2017 Teacher Institute at the National Gallery of Art in Washington, DC, Susan demonstrated and lectured on figurative oil painting techniques of the Venetian Renaissance. Currently, she is on the faculty at The Art League and the University of Maryland. She is represented at Principle Gallery in Alexandria, VA.






